

## RMI TRAINING: PREVENTIVE MEASURES TAKEN DURING THIS TIME OF COVID-19

- Limiting the number of trainees per session, for example not allowing a class of more than 20 trainees. Note that, a class of 20 trainees will be accommodated in a room that is normally occupied by 50 trainees plus;
- Temperature screening is instituted at the entry points,
- Face masks are a must for everyone and everywhere in public;
- Hand washing using running water and soap or hand sanitizers can be found at different entry points like reception, dinning and hostels;
- Social distancing: At least one meter between people in training rooms, dining hall and everywhere on campus;
- To avoid sharing of computers and papers, each trainee will use their own laptop, and training content and other information are shared via email;
- Hostels: For resident trainees, each person stays in a self-contained room;
- Frequent cleaning of surfaces in public places such desks, handrails, door handles and others:
- Raise awareness through posters and holding training sessions with employees and trainees about COVID-19 and how to prevent it;
- Maintaining contact with the nearest COVID-19 Command Post to RMI campuses for required information and advice.
